FEES

No post dated checks. ALL fees must accompany entries in US Funds ONLY.

Make checks payable to Lincoln State Cat Club, Inc.

There will be a \$10.00 substitution fee.

Returned Check Charge - \$50.

No refunds.

The entry clerk will phone COLLECT to clarify questionable entries. The entry clerk will send confirmation of entry to exhibitors after the receipt of the entry forms.

All entries (mail, online, fax) must be paid in full within 10 days of receipt or prior to start of the show, whichever is first. Confirmation will be sent by email unless otherwise requested. A map of the area will be included with the confirmation.

Show Hall – The Oak Lawn Pavilion is located at 9401 S. Oak Park Ave, Oak Lawn, IL, 2 miles east of I-294, exit at 12/20/ 95th St. **FREE PARKING!** Directions to the show hall will be provided with your confirmation. The show hall is climate controlled and handicap accessible. Show hall is a non-smoking facility.

Some Area Motels - Holiday Inn Southwest, Oak Lawn; Amerisuites, Burr Ridge (10.8 miles); Red Roof Inn Chicago/Lansing (13.7 miles); Red Roof Inn Chicago/Willowbrook (10.2 miles). Please check with the hotels to insure that they will accept pets.

General - All championship, premiership and registered kitten entries will be scored for CFA National and Regional awards. Permanent flats will be used. All entries must be registered with CFA except kittens. No kittens under the age of four months will be allowed in the show hall. This show is licensed by the Cat Fanciers' Association, Inc. All CFA Show Rules will be strictly enforced. To obtain a copy of the current Show Rules, send your request with \$5 to CFA, PO Box 1005, Manasquan, NJ 08736-1005.

This is a non-vetted show. You are advised to have your entries inoculated by a licensed veterinarian against feline enteritis, feline rhinotracheitis, calici virus, rabies and have FeL-V tested before entering. All claws of all entries must be clipped prior to benching.

Litter will be provided. Please bring litter pans, food/water dishes and cat food. Single cage size is 21" x 21" x 21".

Liability – Lincoln State Cat Club, Inc. will take reasonable care to safeguard the property of exhibitors. Neither the club; its members, CFA; nor the Oak Lawn Pavilion will be liable for any loss or damage.

Household Pets – HHP will be judged in 8 rings. Lovely awards will be given to the winners.

All household pets 8 months and over MUST BE NEUTERED OR SPAYED. The Show Committee may require proof of altering. Altered HHP kittens (4 through 7 months) as well as unaltered HHP kittens may be shown in accordance with CFA show rules. De-clawed cats cannot be shown in conformation classes per CFA show rules.
